Marcellus Shale: Trying to Drill it Well

Because it may prove to be a very productive gas development, the Marcellus shale formation may be among the most exciting energy finds in recent years. Despite its potential, the Marcellus development presents several significant environmental challenges for Pennsylvania: erosion and sedimentation issues in areas of special protection watersheds, withdrawal of billions of gallons of water from PA streams, disposal of large volumes of wastewater from drilling and operating processes, among others. This talk will discuss the actions of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) over the past year to oversee Marcellus development in a way that will foster energy production while protecting Pennsylvania's environment.
